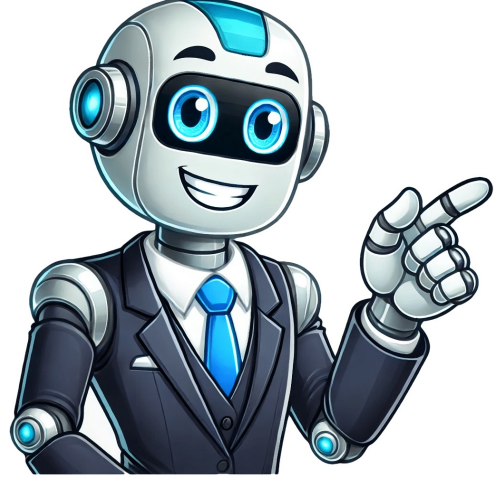


I'm not a robot

Program Description – Culturally Responsive CLAS Grants Program Description 2022 Foundations was one of the WI DHS- Telehealth Behavioral Health Grantees: Foundations Counseling Center has partnered with the Belleville School District to provide telehealth services to children and families who are in need of mental health services. 2022 Dane County Outpatient Infrastructure Grant: Foundations was selected to receive an Infrastructure Grant Supporting Outpatient Providers for Underserved Populations from Dane County. Our intention for this grant is to continue to expand mental health services to serve infants, toddlers, and young children (ages 0-5 and their caregivers). This population of children ages 0-5, is underserved in Dane County and beyond, as there are limited providers available who have been trained to meet the mental health needs of children 0-5 and their caregivers and serve them in a developmentally appropriate manner. DHS/UW-Whitewater QTT grants program: Foundations was a grant recipient for the 3rd year in a row. For 2022 we received the Continuing Expanding Agency award for supervising and hiring Qualified Treatment Trainees (QTTs). 2022 HCBS Home and Community Based Services Grant: The Wisconsin Department of Health Services made possible by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). Foundations was one of 43 grant recipients out of 700 who applied to receive this grant. This grant will help Foundations focus on improving home and community-based services for people who are elderly or have disabilities. Foundations will utilize this grant to retain and hire new mental health therapists in order to provide in-home mental health services and group therapy to Partnership and Family Care clients across 9 counties. Foundations Counseling Center Inc. has a full time position opening for a mental health in-home therapist to work with children, adults and families in Dane, Rock, Iowa and Dodge Counties. Ideal candidates will be licensed as a clinical social worker, professional counselor or marriage and family therapist. Candidates with an APSW or training license will also be considered. The ideal candidate will have a strong clinical background, work well independently as well as on a team, and have good organizational/time management skills. Travel within counties is typically required for in person sessions, but some Telehealth sessions can also be done remotely. Foundations has an independent and flexible work environment that offers mileage reimbursement, flexible hours, a home based office, telehealth, optional compensated on-call, paid and in-house training days, paid paperwork time, a stipend for education and a computer as well as an employer paid work cell phone.
