Explore More To report a child absent, parents are to complete this absentee web form before 8:00 a.m. and indicate the reason for the absence. The absence is considered unexcused until this form is completed. After 10 cumulative absences or 3 unexcused absences, a child is considered truant and will necessitate a school attendance improvement conference with administration and parents. Notice for an absence due to a family trip is to be presented in writing to the Level Director two weeks in advance. It is strongly recommended that such trips coincide with student holidays and do not conflict with cumulative and standardized testing days. Upon returning, the student is responsible to make up missed assignments. To report a child late, parents are to call the front desk before 8:00 a.m. and indicate the reason and time of the late arrival. If a student needs to leave school early, a note stating the reason is to be sent in advance to the front desk. Students who leave school early will be picked up and signed out at the McCoy Center lobby. Parents may not pick up students from the classroom.
