Physical design engineer salary in canada

Physical Design Engineers in Canada can expect an average salary of C\$97,190 by 2025, with pay ranging from C\$76k to C\$135k. Their responsibilities include collaborating with teams, managing design-related tasks and budgets, designing chip elements beyond FETs, creating floor plans, verifying schematic-to-layout consistency, and debugging issues. Typically, a Physical Design Engineer should hold at least a bachelor's degree in engineering and 2-3 years of professional experience to qualify for the role. Increasing salary as a Physical Design Engineer is feasible through several means: switching employers who offer higher pay for similar skills, acquiring advanced degrees that can lead to promotions and increased income potential, or managing more junior engineers which may result in higher earnings. However, it's noted that our data indicates CA\$NaN as both the highest and lowest pay for a Physical Design Engineer annually without specifying these figures.
