Forget everything you know about numbers. In fact, forget you even know what a number is. This is where mathematics starts. Instead of math with "things" (we define this word later) and then we gather

doesn't matter where each member appears, so long as it is there. Subsets When we define a set, if we take pieces of that set, we can form what is called a subset. A subset of this is {1, 2, 3}. Another subset is {3, 4} or even another is {1}, etc. But {1, 6} is not a subset, since it has an element (6) which is not in the parent set. In general: A is a
subset of B if and only if every element of A is in B. So let's use this definition in some examples. 1 is in A, and 4 is in B. That's all the elements of A, and every single one is in B, so we're done. Yes, A is a subset of B Note that 2 is in B, but 2 is not in A. But remember, that doesn't
matter, we only look at the elements in A. Let's try a harder example. Well, we can't check every element in these sets, because they have an infinite number of elements.
