In typical HoYoverse fashion, gacha mechanics will let players recruit new Agents to perform better in combat. It's a system that is usually joined by grindy mechanics to encourage spending, so players should know that they're unlikely to get the agents or weapons they want in a hurry.Zenless Zone Zero StoryZenless Zone Zero is an upcoming game by HoYoverse, the developer of Genshin Impact and Honkai Star Rail. Here's a breakdown of the top W-Engines for Jane Doe.W-ENGINESTATSW-ENGINE EFFECTSSharpenerStingerBase ATK: 714Anomaly Proficiency: 90Indulge in the Hunt: Upon activating a Dash Attack, gain 1 stack of Predatory Instinct. Each stack of Predatory Instinct increases the equipper's Physical DMG by 12% for 10s, stacking up to 3 times. This effect can trigger once every 0.5s and repeated triggers reset the duration. When entering combat or triggering Perfect Dodge, gain 3 stacks of Predatory Instinct. It's particularly fun for free-to-play players who enjoy seeing big Assault damage numbers. However, like most A-class W-engines, it has some uptime issues, so it's better suited for longer fights.Rainforest Gourmet is another free-to-play option. It allows players to easily manage its buff by using her EX Special, providing a strong and consistent ATK boost. However, it does have some downtime, meaning its performance can lag behind her signature W-Engine. Fusion Compiler is an alternative S-ranked W-Engine for Jane. It provides a solid ATK boost and buffs Anomaly Proficiency with each Special or EX Special Attack.
