Kingston House, long the seat of the dukes of Kingston, is a beautiful example of early 17th-century domestic architecture. If, for example, a knitting needle is stroked with the south pole of a magnet, the strokes being directed from the middle of the needle towards the two extremities alternately, the needle will acquire a north pole at each end and a south pole in the middle. The dimensions of a piece of iron, for example, its elasticity, its thermo-electric power and its electric conductivity are all changed under the influence of magnetization of nickel, it follows from theory that the length of a nickel rod should be diminished by magnetization and conversely. Many of their compounds are very strongly magnetic, erbium, for example, in the canon of Melito of Sardis, and in the prefaces and letters of Jerome. We are told that the universal example of his colleagues, rather than any desire for female society, impelled him to matrimony; his choice being a lady of the Conti family, who, by his request, joined him at Berlin. The Mithraeum hewn in the tufa quarries of the Capitoline Hill at Rome, still in existence during the Renaissance, is an

example. Those at Santos and Manaos, for example, have produced good results. Rio and Santos, although both evinced a desire of independence, followed the example of the Paulistas. Numbers of English artisans and shipbuilders, Swedish ironfounders, German engineers sought fortunes in the new country, and diffused industry by their example. The choir (restored in 1873 by public subscription) is a fine example of 15th-century architecture, and the Gothic crown surmounting the central tower forms one of the most characteristic features in every view of the city.
