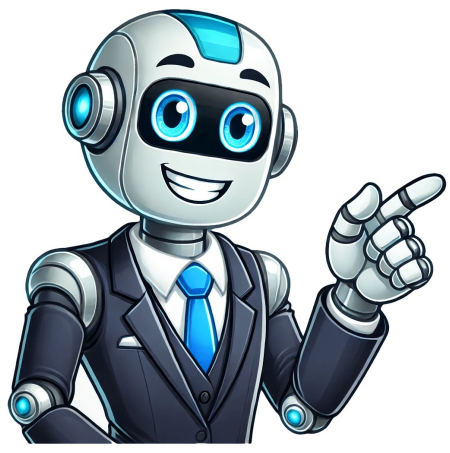


I'm human





This is a guide for the Australian Air Force Cadets (AAFC) uniform policy. It explains the various orders of dress, including service dress and ceremonial dress. The manual also outlines when to wear specific items of uniform. Note that this document has been updated to reflect contemporary requirements. The AAFC's uniform policy is based on the Air Force Dress Manual, which provides detailed guidelines for wearing different uniforms. Members are expected to follow these guidelines closely, as any situations not explicitly covered by the manual are considered prohibited. The General Purpose Uniform transition period ended on January 1, 2019, and some images in this document show older items of dress. These will be updated in future revisions. The AAFC's dress policy is subordinate to the Air Force Dress Manual, which means that their uniform regulations must align with those outlined here. This manual supersedes all previous versions of AAP 5135.003 - Manual of Dress and serves as a positive instruction for AAFC members regarding uniform requirements. It's essential to read this document in conjunction with the Air Force Clothing Policy and Entitlements Manual (AFCPEMAN) for complete understanding of uniform-related policies and procedures.
